### About

Then Again is Bob Chambers on guitar and vocals and Cyril Cianflone on bass and vocals. The duo has played together for over 30 years. Individually and additionally, Bob and Cyril have played with Laura Nyro, Felix Cavaliere of the Rascals, Carmine Appice, Eddie Money, Vinnie Vincent, and the Cowsills.

Their set is centered on the music of the Everly Brothers, with a stripped-down format built around guitar, bass, and two-part harmonies. Rather than using two guitars or additional supporting instruments, Then Again works with the duo format to give the songs a fuller, richer live sound while keeping the focus on the vocal blend that defined the Everly Brothers.

The show pays tribute to the early rock and roll sound of the Everly Brothers, known for tight harmonies, catchy melodies, and heartfelt lyrics. Then Again performs the well-known classics and also goes deeper into the catalog with lesser-known songs including Sleepless Nights and Don't Ask Me To Be Friends, material that is rarely performed by others.

The Everly Brothers' music sits firmly in classic American roots music, and their influence reached across pop, R&B, and country. Then Again keeps that material front and center in a format that is easy to place and easy to understand: a long-working vocal duo focused on Everly Brothers songs and harmony-driven performance.
