STAGE

FULL PRODUCTION - Minimum stage size of 20' X 25' and a minimum of 3' height. Sound wings should not be attached to stage if ground stacks are to be used. Stage should be solid interlocked construction and have stair units on each side.

HALF PRODUCTION – Minimum stage size of 16' X 20' and a minimum of 3' height.

Note: Outdoor venues must provide covered stage, covered sound area and covered spot light

PRODUCTION

FOH SOUND SYSTEM -MIXING CONSOLE - Minimum 24 Channel w/minimum 8 aux sends. **EFFECTS** – Two(2) digital reverb units

MONITOR SOUND SYSTEM

MONITOR WEDGES – Minimum of 4 professional quality monitor wedges but 6 are preferred.

LIGHTING CONSOLE/DIMMERS – Shall be of sufficient quality and power to control lighting system set up including any lighting effects.

TECHNICIANS/OPERATORS - Purchaser will provide all sound and lighting technicians to set up run and operate all sound and lighting equipment throughout the performance including sound check.

SOUND CHECK - Completion of performance stage is expected no later than one(1) hour prior to earliest production call. ARTIST'S production normally takes two(2) hours set up before sound check. These two(2) hours start after staging, sound and lights are in place.

<u>DRESSING ROOMS</u> Please have 2 private, secured rooms available for artist at load-in time. Minimum 12'x12' with AC control,110 VAC power outlets and bathroom (within 100' from stage), running water, two (2) fresh bars of soap, ten (10) clean towels (minimum), steamer, dressing tables to accommodate seven (7) performers, four (4) clothing racks, full length mirrors (at least two) and ten (10) chairs. Rooms are to be exclusive to Elton the Early Years and not shared with other artist, patrons, guests, venue personnel or convention center
