P.A. REQUIREMENTS

THE MIXING CONSOLE SHOULD BE AT LEAST A (24) CHANNEL MACKIE 1604 OR BETTER. A MINIMUM OF FOUR SEPARATE MONITOR MIXES. THE NUMBER AND SIZE OF THE SPEAKER CABINETS AND AMPS MAY VARY DEPENDING ON THE SIZE OF THE EVENT AND CERTAIN CONDITIONS SUCH AS: INDOORS OR OUTDOORS LARGE OR SMALL ROOM ETC. CALL DMH ENTERPRISES TO DISCUSS P.A. REQUIREMENTS IN MORE DETAIL IF NEEDED.

- (4) VOCAL MICS: SURE 58s OR BETTER
- (4) ACTIVE DIRECT BOXES
- (6) MICS FOR DRUM KIT AND TWO OVERHEAD MICS FOR CYMBALS
- (1) WIRELESS MIC FOR LEAD VOCAL (58 OR BETTER)

MONITOR REQUIREMENTS

- (5) FLOOR WEDGES MINIMUM
- * ALL NECESSARY CABLES, EXTENSION CORDS, BUS BOXES ETC.

BACKLINE REQUIREMENTS (IF APPLICABLE)

- (1) SIX PIECE STANDARD DRUM KIT (TAMA OR BETTER) WITH DOUBLE HEADED BASS DRUM, CYMBALS AND HARDWARE (see above for sizes)
- (1) LARGE BASS AMP (PREFERABLY GALLIEN KRUGER 800 OR BETTER)
- (1) GUITAR AMP (PREFERABLY A VOX AC30 or MESA DUAL RECTIFIER)
- (1) ELECTRIC KEYBOARD/PIANO WITH STAND AND BENCH (ROLAND, KORG, ETC...) 88 KEY WEIGHTED IF POSSIBLE
- (4) BOOM MIC STANDS FOR VOCALS
- (1) STRAIGHT ROUND BASED MIC STAND FOR LEAD VOCAL

HOSPITALITY RIDER

- (1) CLEAN DRESSING ROOM AREA **WITH FULL LENGTH MIRROR**
BOTTLED WATER, SODA OR JUICE (MEALS REQUIRED DEPENDING ON EVENT)
- (5) TOWELS FOR BAND MEMBERS

ALCOHOL WHEN AVAILABLE BEER ETC. FOR POST SHOW.

TRAVEL DAY REQUIRED FOR OUT OF TOWN SHOWS WITH FLIGHTS DEPENDING OF FLIGHT DURATION.

FOUR SEPARATE HOTEL ROOMS FOR BAND MEMBERS WHEN OUT OF TOWN.
